

RIDE-SHARE SAFETY

- Before you request a ride, review the safety features in the app, so you know how to use them.
- Avoid spending unnecessary time outside alone with your phone in your hand. Instead, wait indoors until the app shows your driver has arrived.
- Before you get in the car, check the license plate, driver photo, and driver name all match what's listed in the app.
- If you are riding alone, sit in the backseat; this ensures you can safely exit on either side of the vehicle to avoid moving traffic.
- Trust your instincts and use your best judgment when riding with Uber. If you ever feel you're in an emergency situation, call 911 immediately.
