In order to begin your AFROTC application, we require that you provide the documents listed in the attachment that pertains to you upon your arrival to the Detachment. You will be expected to participate in all AFROTC sponsored events as well as meet all requirements (e.g. academics, physical fitness, and good moral character). Many exciting job opportunities exist for you in the Air and Space Forces. Additionally, if you qualify, AFROTC offers scholarship opportunities that will help pay for tuition and books.
