Mr. Doran serves as the Recruiting Operations Officer for the Blue Ridge Battalion, Army ROTC Department, Virginia Military Institute. Upon completion of the Field Artillery Officer's Basic Course, his first duty assignment was at Fort Polk, Louisiana, where he served as a Fire Support Officer in 4th Battalion, 1st Field Artillery, 5th Infantry Division (Mechanized).
