- Field Training once a semester










VMI Army ROTC Summer Training Events

Scholarships

- National 4 & 3 year scholarships: https://www.goarmy.com/rotc/scholarships
- Campus Based Scholarships: 3 & 2 year scholarships are available

Benefits

- Scholarships pay 100% tuition plus fees
- \$1200 annually for books
- \$911 annual uniform allowance
- ROTC stipend: \$420.00 per school month

Obligation –

Scholarship: 4yr AD/ 4yr ARNG, USAR, IRR Non-Scholarship: 3yr AD/ 5yr ARNG, USAR, IRR

ARNG or USAR: 6yr/2yr IRR

Virginia Army National Guard Simultaneous Membership Program (SMP)

- Can commission as an officer in the Active Duty Army, Army Reserves or Army National Guard through VMI ROTC. NOT DEDICATED to VANG unless on NG Scholarship
- Monthly SMP drill with VA National Guard in Lexington (VMI/ROTC schedule dependent)
- Benefits
 - Federal Tuition Assistance: \$4,000 per year (After completion of AIT)
 - VA State Tuition Assistance: \$20,000 per year (After completion of BCT)
 - · Drill check: Approximately \$350 per month
 - SMP Kicker: Approximately \$350 per month (Contracted Cadets)
 - ROTC Stipend: Approximately \$420 per month (Contracted Cadets)
 - Access to Tricare Reserve Select
 - Time in service begins at enlistment (additional \$900 monthly as 2LT)





ROTC Stipend (\$420)

- + GI Bill (\$439)
- + ROTC Kicker (\$350)
- + Drill Pay (\$321)
- = \$1,488 per month!
- ~ Up to 24k
