Command Senior Chief Shawn Wingle is a native of Monroe, Michigan. He enlisted in the United States Navy in September of 2005. Following completion of basic training in Great Lakes, Illinois, he reported for training to Airman Apprenticeship School in Pensacola, Florida where he learned basic concepts of the Aviation platform.

Senior Chief Wingle's assignments include tours with the USS GEORGE WASHINGTON (CVN-73), where he designated as an Aviation Ordnanceman and later conducted a homeport change from Norfolk, VA to Yokosuka, Japan; he's been assigned to Guantanamo Bay, Cuba in support of detainee operations; Fleet Readiness Center West, Lemoore CA as the Production Control Leading Petty Officer; the USS ABRAHAM LINCOLN (CVN-72) as the Leading Chief Petty Officer for G-1 Division within Weapons Department; his most recent assignment was at the United States Naval Academy where he served as the Leading Chief Petty Officer for 1st Battalion. While stationed at the Naval Academy, Senior Chief Wingle was selected into the Command Senior Chief Program.



Senior Chief Wingle has earned his Master's Degree in Organizational Leadership from Arizona State University, he's obtained a Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice/Homeland Security; he's a graduate of the Senior Enlisted Academy (class 238) and the Chief of the Boat (COB)/ Command Master Chief (CMC) Capstone course (class 22110); he's qualified as a Master Training Specialist, and was selected as the United States Navy's 2018 Bob Feller Act of Valor award recipient.
