

For Academic Year 2021-22, VMI charges all cadets a comprehensive auxiliary fee totaling \$6,684. The auxiliary fee covers the cadet's share of the cost of medical services, cadet activities/facilities, athletics and other services. The portion of this fee allocated for cadet facilities/activities totals \$2,402 and includes funding for facilities maintenance, debt service, cadet counseling services, and various cadet organizations. A list of cadet organizations receiving an operating budget of \$100 or more from this fee is provided below. The funding for these organizations total \$487,000 and represents approximately \$287 of the auxiliary fee paid by cadets based on a budgeted yearly average student enrollment of 1,697 cadets.
