Virginia Military Institute is required by federal regulations to determine whether a student is maintaining Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) in his or her chosen degree plan. Students who have been denied federal financial aid because they have not met the requirements of the VMI SAP Policy are offered the opportunity to complete the VMI Financial Aid appeal process to be considered for an exemption from the policy.

In some cases, a student's failure to meet SAP requirements is due to events beyond the student's control. If there are documentable circumstances for the term(s) when the student's deficiencies occurred, the student may submit this completed appeal form and provide a written statement and documentation as noted below.
